ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The policy of Audlem Public Hall Management Committee is to protect and to improve the local environment and ensure that consideration for the environment is taken into account in all decisions made by the Committee.

The aims of the Management Committee are:

- Make the most efficient use of energy and encourage energy saving in our use of oil, electricity and water
- Promote recycling and avoid waste
- Encourage those using and visiting the Hall to reduce car journeys through use of walking, cycling, car sharing or public transport
- Minimise all forms of pollution
- Work with a local environmental group (Audlem & District Acting Positively for Transition) to consider and promote environmental issues
- Ensure that the potential environmental impact of any building projects will be assessed and minimised
- Raise the awareness of Hall users of their responsibility and understanding for the environment including the impact of noise on our neighbours
- Use local suppliers and contractors wherever possible
- Provide a focal point for Conservation and Amenity issues
